SPRING MEETING.

MATCHES WITH OTHER CLUBS.

The question of having matches with other clubs was discussed generally, and several suggestions were put forward by members for the consideration of the Council. The promotion and form of competitions for club members was also discussed, but no decision was come to, this being left to the Council.

DONATION OF TROPHY AND PRIZE.

Mr Dougall intimated that he would give a Trophy for annual competition at the Spring Meeting, this Trophy to remain in the winner's possession for one year and to be delivered up by him to the Secretary previous to the next Spring Meeting of the Club. Mr Lockhart intimated that he would provide a golf club as an additional prize for the winner at the Spring Meeting. The members expressed their appreciation and thanks to the donors of these prizes.
